

During this module your children learn all about the importance of listening skills.



Children get to do lots of practising of these listening skills






Listening skills

Why not practice these skills at home too?








Relate story

Once upon a time there was a little girl called Rose, she lived on a busy street, and her favourite thing to do was read!




One day Rose had to choose a book to bring to school, in the end she decided on her favourite 'Oscar's Enormous Ears'






The teacher asked the children to come to the carpet and sit quietly with their books. She asked them not to look at each others books or chatter!



Rose was the only one who listened to the teacher so she got to read her book first! Her teacher asked her why she chose this book and Rose explained that it was because this book taught her to listen!





We really encourage you to practice the listening skills at home. Each day try and have at least one conversation where you and your child both practice the 3 skills they have learnt at school (you can use the poster to remind them!)

Top tips: try to remove distractions and really focus on what your child is saying. Get the whole family involved!
