What the different character strengths are and what they mean


How children can use their strengths to be their best selves

How to practice using these different strengths






The children learn about the following strengths in school, it is great if you can familiarise yourself with these and introduce the language at home and in your own strengths spotting (see habits at home!)








Celebrate story

Celebrate story




He was so excited about finding the pot of gold that he got lost! He met some friends along the way and they said they'd help him to get home!
